


A Lesson on The Astronaut's Diary by Jaclyn Manning

Grade Level: Grade 4

Subject Area: English Language Arts **Lesson Length**: 1 hour 45 minutes

Lesson Keywords: Reading, Vocabulary, Space, Critical thinking

Lesson Description: Read the short story called "The Astronaut Diary" answer vocabulary questions, followed by a

class discussion leading to the final writing assignment.
