

A Lesson on A Better Community by Heather Connor

Grade Level: Grade 3 Subject Area: English Language Arts

Lesson Length: 1 hour

Lesson Description: This lesson's goal is to have students be exposed to new concepts and vocabulary. Students will also create their own thoughtful reflection on recycling and utilize new vocabulary. The student will watch a short film on recycling and write about the impact they can have on their community.
